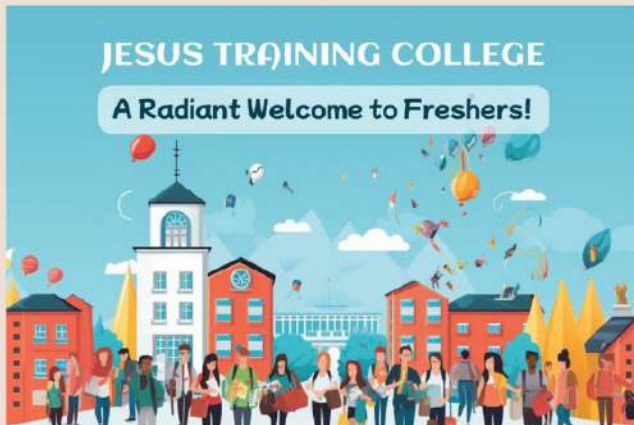
A solo song and a fusion dance performance brightened the function. Mr. Martin Joseph proposed a vote of thanks at the end of the programme.

FAREWELL DAY 2023



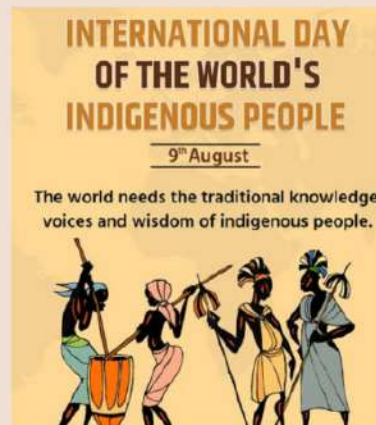

QUIT INDIA MOVEMENT DAY 2023



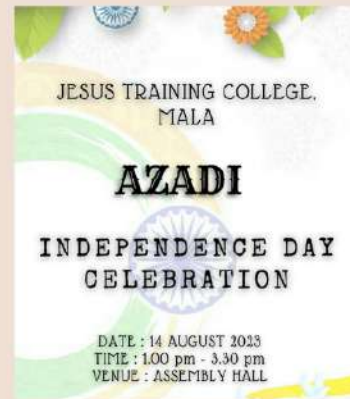
