




World Refugee Day

World Anti-Drug Day




<u>Hardhika</u>


Quit India Movement Day


International Youth Day


Teacher's Day


Academic batch inauguration and convocation


International Peace Day


World Heart Day


Festal Celebration of Fr. Rapai P C


Gandhi Jayanti


Patent for Leya-Honouring ceremony


Food Fest


Stat-o-rama


Kerala Piravi


National Day of the Girl Child


Field Trip


Constitution Day


World AIDS Day


World Soil Day


Christmas Celebration


National Youth Day


Festal Celebration of Executive Director Fr. Binoy Kozhippatt


Sports Day


Republic Day


International Mother Language Day


Meet the Candidate


College Union Election
