
1.Provision in the Time Table


- A total number of mentees allotment to each mentor shall be according to the ratio of total admitted students




After each exam, teachers provide immediate feedback and encouragement to students. This practice helps students understand their strengths and areas for improvement, fostering continuous academic growth and motivation.


