2.4.6: Students Develop Competence to Organize Academic, Cultural, Sports, and Community-Related Events

The students of Jesus Training College Mala, during their practice teaching session in various schools from 11/9/2023 to 19/12/2023, actively participated in numerous programs and events. These included planning and participating in various academic, cultural, sports, and community-related events, which were instrumental in developing several competencies in them.

1. Planning and Scheduling Academic, Cultural, and Sports Events in School

• Planning and Executing Lessons for the Students

During their practice teaching program, the students of Jesus Training College Mala demonstrated commitment and dedication in organizing and carrying out various academic activities. These included determining learning objectives, creating lesson plans that incorporated teaching techniques, resources, and evaluation methods, and providing differentiated instruction and meet the needs of a wide range of students' active engagement and interaction with one another. They demonstrated proficiency in areas of classroom management, such as establishing classroom rules, managing classroom discipline, and maintaining a polite and productive environment for effective teaching and learning.

• Construction and administering of various tests.

Preparation and utilization of various learning resources and ict integrated learning materials

During Preparative assignments, the student teachers of Jesus Training College, Mala actively contributed to the creation of a variety of learning resources to assist their instruction teaching methods. They effectively used various audio-visual aids and materials to demonstrate concepts and engage students effectively in the teaching-learning process employed to make learning interactive and enjoyable. • Old age home visit and Donation of goods

As part of the community living camp, the students and staff of Jesus Training College visited Abhaya Bhavan, Porathissery. A gift was prepared that included the necessary materials that they would have required and was donated.

Medical camp

The community living camp of the students of the batch 2023-25 included conduction of a Medical camp on 7th June, 2024. The camp was conducted in association with the doctors of Gurudharma and Apollo Hospitals. Doctors of various departments provided free consultation to not just the staff and students of the college but also the people from the community of Mala.

• Cleaning of Kazhimbran beach

As part of the community living camp of the students of the batch 2022-24, a visit was made to Kazhimbran Beach where the students of Jesus Training College took part in cleaning the premises all the while enjoying the beauty of nature.

• Community living camp

The community living camp "Anamayam" was organised by the college and Advaya Union from August 18th to 23rd August 2023. The Camp was inaugurated Mala on 18th August 2023. On 21st August, the second day of the camp began with the first session on counselling was organised by AVARD Resource team who took class on post covid problems faced by adolescent students, and on different learning strategies and learning style. The second session was on the topic Women Health and Hygiene.

On 22nd August 2023, an eye camp was organised by Vasan Eye Care along with our college from 9:30 pm to 12:30 pm. Staffs, students and people from Mala and other localities benefitted from this camp. From 1:30 pm to 4:30 pm the teachers and students visited Abhaya Bhavan, Porathissery and later the Snehatheeram beach. On 23rd August 2023, the morning session was conducted, on the topic "The role of yoga in health management".

• Daily assembly

Each day starts with an assembly from 9:15 am to 9:40 am. The assembly include prayer, national pledge, news reading as well a thought for the day, concluding with the national anthem. Three of the days of the week are allocated for introduction of a book, facts related to each optional subject as well as articles of the Indian constitution respectively.

• Organizing Sports Meets

To encourage student collaboration and physical fitness, Jesus Training College students were tasked with planning a sports competition. The primary objective of the sports meet was to encourage active participation in sports and to instil values of sportsmanship and companionship among students.

• Quiz
